Do the end that you that your Honors may pass a Decree directing said two Lots of Ground with the improvements thereon to be sold clear of said encumbrance by a trustee or trustees to be thereby appointed by your Honorable Court and the proceeds arising from such sale after payment of the costs attending those proceedings, usual trustees Commissions and expenses of Sale divided among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective rights.

1st May it please your Honors to grant to your Orotors the State of Maryland writ of subpoena directed to said Anne M. Plummer, Samuel W. Plummer and Mary C. Plummer, his wife, George M. Smith and James Smith defendants herein and residents of Frederick County of our said commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court in person or by Solicitor on or before a day certain to be therein named to answer fully this Bill of Complaint and stand to abide by and perform such order or decree as your Honors may pass in the premises.

2^d And your Orotors further pray your Honors to grant unto them an order of publication notifying said non-resident defendants of the substance and object of this Bill and commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court by a day certain to be therein named to answer fully said Bill and stand to abide by and perform such order or decree as this Court may pass in the premises.

3. And your Orotors further pray your Honors to grant unto them such other and further relief as their case may require and to your Honors shall seem just and right and

This Indenture made this eleventh day of October Eighteen Hundred & fifty-three, between William Plummer of Frederick County, Maryland of the one part & Jesse Plummer of said County & State of the other part Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred dollars current money by the said Jesse Plummer to the said William Plummer in hand paid, at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents; the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said William Plummer hath bargained, sold, aliened & conveyed & by these presents doth give, grant bargain & sell, alien, convey, release convey & confirm unto the said Jesse Plummer his heirs & assigns Lot No 4. front Lot in the Town of New Market in said County with the improvements thereon also back lot No. 21 in said town, also the farm owned by said William Plummer, containing about ninety acres lying on the east side of the Road leading from New Market to Liberty adjoining the town of New
