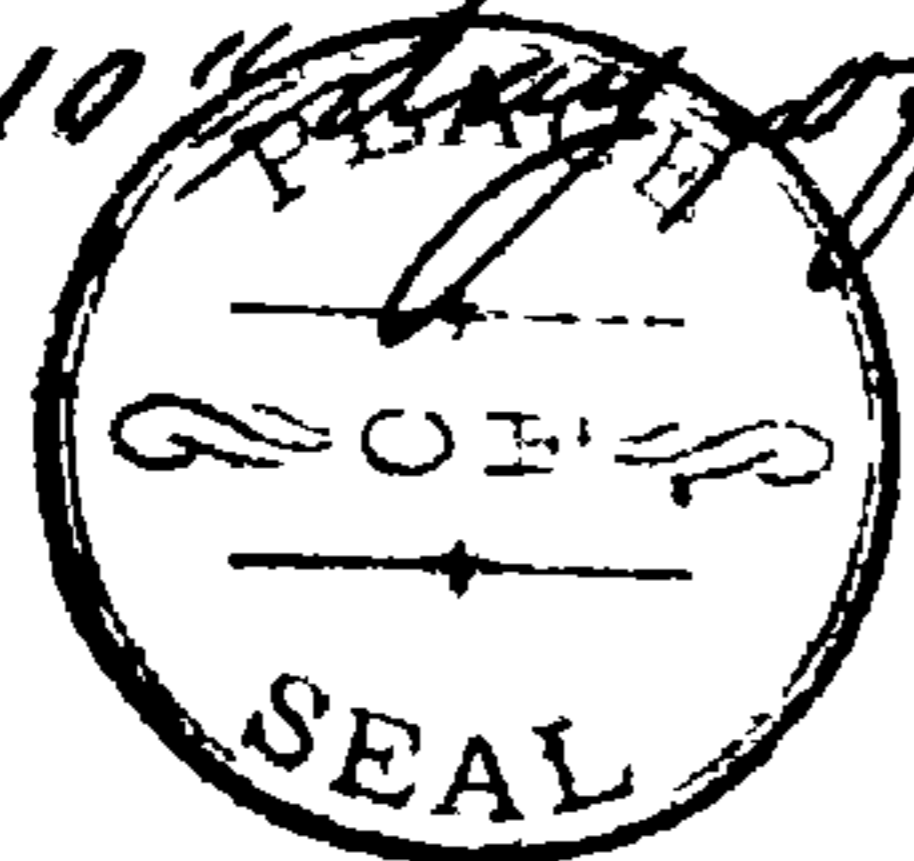

At the request of Magdalena Biddinger the following Deed is recorded July 13th 1878

This Deed made this twenty eighth day of June in the year Eighteen Hundred and seventy-seven by Samuel Putman and Elizabeth A. his wife of Frederick County Md. Witnesses that in consideration of Seven Hundred and forty Dollars (\$740⁰⁰) the said Samuel and Elizabeth A. Putman do grant in fee simple unto Magdalena Biddinger of Carroll County Maryland, all that small farm or tract of Land, situate in the 17th Election District of said Frederick County, about one and one eighth of a mile South West of Good Intent School House, containing twenty-nine Acres of Land, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to Sarah A. V. Putman by Jacob Stetly of J and Joseph Groff, Attorneys for David Tates and wife by Deed recorded in Liber D. No. 2. folio 229, and conveyed in a Mortgage from Sarah A. V. Putman and Hezekiah Putman to said Samuel Putman recorded in Liber P.O. No. 1 folio 627, said Libers being of the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid, and being the same property sold and ratified to said Samuel Putman in the Mortgage's sale set forth in No. 4095 Equity Docket of the Ct. Court for Fredk County sitting as a Court of Equity, as will duly appear from the Courts Order passed in said cause on the 14th day of August 1875, and by reference to which Deed Mortgage
