Maryland, respectfully represents unto your Honors,

1st That, on or about the twenty fifth day of September in the year
eighteen Hundred and eighty four, one George W. W. Hurley
a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, departed this life, in-
testate, seized and possessed among other Real Estate of certain tracts of
Mountain land, which are fully described in certified copies of the deeds
conveying the same to him, as recorded among the Land Records of Frede-
rick County, herewith filed respectively as Exhibits No. 1, 2 & 3, which Exhibits
