The Plaintiffs filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibit Numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4 which are herewith retained by said examiner

Lewis Hurley a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Examiner and herewith returned, deposes and says:-

To 1st Int - 1st Ans. My name is Lewis Hurley, My age is 57 years My residence is near Wolfsville, Frederick County Maryland.

To the 2nd Int. - 2nd Ans. - I am acquainted with the parties to this suit and have known them for a number of years

To 3rd Int. - 3rd Ans. I was he is dead, he died in September 1884 in Frederick County, Md. He died intestate.

To the 4th Int. - 4th Ans. He did not.

To 5th Int. - 5th Ans. He did, he left the following, of Dites, Catharine Selman, Married to David Selman (a brother Jacob H. Hurley whose wife's name is Mary, a brother John E. Hurley whose wife's name is Mary Ann, a brother Lewis Hurley whose wife's name is Mary A. E. and the following nephews & resides, John W. Blickenstaff whose wife's name is Mary J. - Mary J. Kelbaugh whose husband's name is Louis H. Kelbaugh, Annancy E. Wolf whose husband's name is Jonathan Wolfe, George W. Blickenstaff, whose wife's name is Mary, Lydia A. Bartge, whose husband's name is Albert W. Bartge, all these are adults.

To 6th Int. - 6th Ans. - His niece Mary J. Kelbaugh who died leaving two children named John & Walter, as her heirs at law, and also a husband named Lewis H. She died intestate

To 7th Int - 7th Ans. - All are adults except John & Walter Kelbaugh, who are infants they all reside in Frederick County with the exception of Lewis H. Kelbaugh who lives in Carroll County Maryland, John W. Blickenstaff & wife who live in Indiana, Joseph H. Hurley & wife who live in Iowa, and John E. Hurley & wife who live in Kansas.

To 8th Int. - 8th Ans. - He died seized & possessed of lands described in Exhibits 1, 2, and 3 situated in Frederick County, Maryland, they are Mountain Lots.

To 9th Int - 9th Ans. - The witness here looks at Exhibit No 4 shows him, and says, I sent it to the parties whose names are attached to it
