George W. Blickenstaff, whose wife's name is Mary, and Lydia A. Bartz, whose husband's name is Albert W. Bartz, all three are adults to the 6th Int. - 6th Ans. His wife Mary J. Kelbaugh has died, having no children named John & Walter, as her heirs at law, and, also, a husband, name Lewis H. - she died intestate

To the 7th Int. - 7th Ans. - All are Adults, excepting John, and Walter, Kelbaugh, who are infants, they all reside in Frederick County, Md. with the exception of Lewis H. Kelbaugh who lives in Carroll County, Md. John W. Blickenstaff, and wife who live in Indiana, Josiah H. Hargley, & wife who live in Iowa, and John H. Hargley, & wife, who live in Kansas.

To the 8th Int. - 8th Ans. - He did, seized, and possessed of lands, described in Exhibits Nos 1, 2, and 3, situated in Frederick County, Maryland they are Mountain Lots.

To the 9th Int. - 9th Ans. The witness here looks at Exhibit No 4 shown him, and says "I know the hand writing of the larger part of these persons whose names are attached to that paper, and I believe that their signatures are genuine, I know that Mr. Lewis Hargley sent the paper to some of the parties whose names are attached to their signatures, and they returned it to him signed, there had been an understanding between some of the heirs, I know, of George W. Hargley, that Lewis Hargley was to sell for them the lands, and property of George W. Hargley, and I believe that the paper marked Exhibit No. 4, was drawn up as a power of Attorney for him to make the sales, we all supposed it would be sufficient, and legal.

To the 10th Int. - 10th Ans. - I know all the lands described in Exhibits Marked Nos. 1, 2, and 3, were sold by Lewis Hargley, he sold to James Delander, at \$100 per acre, the tract mentioned in Exhibit No. 1, as Lot No 3, on Plat D, containing 14 acres of Land, more or less, this sale was made March 20/85, as was also the subsequent mentioned sales. He sold to Henry Show a tract of Land, mentioned in Exhibit No. 1, as Lot No. 8, on Plat F, containing 2 1/2 acres of Land, at \$25 per acre. He sold to Abraham Jones, at \$300 per acre, the tract mentioned in Exhibit No 2, containing 10 acres and 22 perches of Land, he sold to Robert Pryor, at \$1000 per acre, a tract mentioned in Exhibit No. 3, containing 8 1/2 acres of Land.

To the 11th Int. - 11th Ans. They were put in, perfective.

To the 12th Int. - 12th Ans. I do not know

To the 13th Int. - 13th Ans. They were satisfied, as far as I know, I have heard no complaint.

To the 14th Int. - 14th Ans. Yes Sir, she is now dead, I never heard of her having a Will, at all, she left a husband, named Lewis H. Kelbaugh, and two children Walter & John as above stated, she died in July, 1885

To the 15th Int. - 15th Ans. - The said sales, were fairly made, with the concurrence of the parties in interest, they were made, at Public Sale.

To the 16th Int. - 16th Ans. Yes sir.

To the 17th Int. - 17th Ans. - I do not know.

To the 18th Int. propounded by Examiner.

I know of nothing further - Geo. W. Blickenstaff
