Bill of Complaint

To the Honorable, the Judge of said Court, - Your orator George J. Doll
and Ann E. Doll, his wife Lewis H. Doll, and Annis F. Doll, his wife,
Melville E. Doll, and Hannah M. Doll his wife, Samuel C. Doll, and M. Lucretia
Doll his wife, Leander J. Doll, and Annis Dean Doll his wife, Thomas J. Stable,
and Emma W. C. Stable his wife, Mary L. Stable, Annis D. Linn and
Thomas C. Linn, her husband, Harry W. Stable, Catharine H. Stable, and
Charles E. Stable complaining, say: -

1st That Harriet Doll, widow of Ezra Doll, late of Frederick City, State of
Maryland, departed this life, intestate, on the twenty-fifth day of February in
the year One Thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, leaving surviving her
as only heirs at law, George J. Doll, Lewis H. Doll, Melville E. Doll,
Samuel C. Doll, children of Harriet Doll, and residing in the City of
Frederick, State of Maryland, Leander J. Doll, child of Harriet Doll and
residing in the City of Baltimore State of Maryland, Thomas J. Stable,
Mary L. Stable, Harry W. Stable, Catharine H. Stable, Charles E.
Stable, residing in Gettysburg, State of Pennsylvania, children of Louisa
Doll, daughter of Harriet Doll, and Annis D. Stable, wife of Thomas
C. Linn residing in Salisbury, State of North Carolina, and daughter
of Louisa Doll, daughter of Harriet Doll.

2d That the said Thomas J. Stable, Mary L. Stable, Annis D. Stable, wife
of Thomas Linn, Harry W. Stable, Catharine H. Stable, and Charles
E. Stable, are children, only heirs at law and survivors of Louisa Doll, late
of Gettysburg State of Pennsylvania, deceased, and daughter of Harriet
Doll, and that, as such children, and only heirs at law, are entitled, equally
share and share alike, to the distributive share, of their mother Louisa Doll
in the estate of Harriet Doll, said, deceased, intestate.

3d That all the parties to this suit are sui juris, Charles E. Stable
alone except, do he being an infant under twenty-one years of age

4th That your orator as heirs at law of Harriet Doll, are seized in
fee simple as tenants in common of a valuable piece of Real
Estate situated, and being on the South side of East second Street
Frederick City, Maryland, the metes and bounds, of which, are fully
and particularly described in a deed from John Rausburg and
Margaret J. Rausburg his wife to Harriet Doll, dated the first
day of April in the year eightnin hundred and forty - six
and, recorded in Liber W. B. T. No. 5. folio 152 and 153. One
of the Land Records of Frederick County, which said Deed
is herewith filed, as part hereof Marked Exhibit A.
