William V. Albright, a Witness, of lawful age produced, on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories herewith returned deposes and says, as follows: -

1st Inter. Were you, or not, acquainted with Harriet Doll, widow of Graphall late of Frederick County, and if you had any

1st Ans. I was acquainted with her, and knew of her from childhood.

2^d Inter. Is the said Harriet Doll living or dead, if dead, when and where did she die, and did she die Testate, or Intestate?

2^d Ans. She is dead, she died in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland about Feb'y 25th 1886, and she died intestate, as far as any one knew.

3^d Inter. State whether or not the said Harriet Doll left any children or other heirs at law, surviving her, and if you give their names, ages, and places of residence, and if any are married give the names of their husbands, or wives, as the case may be?

3^d Ans. She left children, and heirs at law, as follows: -

(1) A son George J. Doll whose wife's name is Ann E. B. Doll.

(2) A son Lewis H. Doll whose wife's name is Annie F. Doll.

(3) Melville E. Doll, a son, whose wife's name Hannah M. Doll.

(4) Samuel W. Doll whose wife's name is Mrs. Lucretia F. Doll, all of whom are adults, over 21 years of age, and residents of Frederick

(5) Leander J. Deal, whose wife's name is Anna Dean Doll both of whom are adults and residents of Baltimore City.

(6) She had a daughter named Louisa Doll who married Henry J. Stahl of Gettysburg P. M. S. Stahl died some years ago leaving the following children: -

(1) A son, Thomas J. Stahl, married to Emma M. C. Stahl his wife, both of whom are adults and residents of Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania

(2) Mary L. Stahl, an unmarried adult who resides in Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania

(3) Anna D. Lynn, married Thomas S. Lynn both of whom are adults and residents of the State of North Carolina.

(4) A son Harry M. Stahl, an unmarried adult who resides in Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania.

(5) A daughter Katharine H. Stahl, an unmarried adult who resides in Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania, and

(6) A son, Charles E. Stahl, an infant under twenty one years of age who resides in Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania

4th Inter. State whether or not the said Harriet Doll did, seized, and possessed, of any real estate, situated in Frederick County? If you describe it, look at Exhibit A now shown you, and state whether or not that correctly describes the real estate?

4th Ans. She did die, seized, and possessed, of Real Estate situated in Frederick City, in Frederick County. It consists of a two-story Brick House and Lot, situated on the South side of East Second Street, in Frederick City, worth about \$2800. I look at Exhibit A now shown me and that does correctly describe the said land and premises.

5th Inter. State whether or not the said real estate is susceptible of division of partition, among the parties interested without loss and injury, and whether it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties infant as well as adults to have the same sold and the proceeds divided among them, and give your reasons for your answer?
