5th Ans. The Real Estate is not susceptible of division among the parties in interest without loss and injury because it being but a house and lot such particulars would be in the nature of things next to a Physical impossibility. I think it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties to have the same sold and the proceeds divided for the reason that this property is vacant and there is no one specially interested in keeping it up and the natural conveyance will be that it will soon depreciate and go down in value.

Martin N. Rohrbach, a Witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Examines herewith returned, deposes and says as follows: -

1st Inter. Were you or not acquainted with Harriet Doll, widow of Geo. Doll late of Frederick County, and if yes how long?

1st Ans. I was acquainted with her and knew her for many years or longer.

2nd Inter. Is the said Harriet Doll living or dead, if dead, when and where did she die and did she die testate or intestate?

- (4) A son, Samuel W. Doll whose wife's name is M. Lucretia Doll, all of which parties are adults over twenty-one years of age and residents of Frederick County;
- (5) A son, Leander G. Doll, whose wife's name is Anna Deane Doll, both of which are adults and residents of Baltimore City, Maryland; and

She had another daughter named Louisa Doll, who married Emory J. Stable of Gettysburg Pa. Mrs. Stable died some years ago leaving the following children viz.

- (1) A son, Thomas J. Stable, married to Emma M. C. Stable his wife, both of whom are adults and residents of Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania;
- (2) Mary L. Stable an unmarried adult daughter who resides in Gettysburg in the State of Pennsylvania;
- (3) A daughter Anna D., who married Thomas C. Linn, both of whom are adults and residents of the State of North Carolina;
- (4) A son, Harry M. Stable, an unmarried adult who resides in Gettysburg, in the State of Pennsylvania, and
