Margaret A. Garber (Mother, &c.) vs. James Irving Rippeau } No. 5710 Equity. In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court - Your Obedt, Frank C. Howwood, the Trustee in this cause, respectfully shows unto your Honor:-

- 1. That Margaret A. Garber, the mother of the infant defendants in this cause has consented to the sale of the Real Estate herein mentioned, and has agreed to take in lieu of dower such sum of money as may be allowed her by law and your Honorable Court.
- 2. That she is entitled to receive in lieu of dower not more than one seventh nor less than one tenth of the One hundred and forty-four Dollars and eighty-five cents (\$144.85) left after the payment of the costs of this proceeding and the Mortgage claim of William Garber, now in said Trustee's hands.
- 3. That said Margaret A. Garber has been appointed by the Orphan's Court of Frederick County the Guardian for said infant defendants. Therefore, Your Petitioner prays your Honor to pass an order fixing the sum that shall be paid to said Margaret A. Garber in lieu of Dower, and directing said Trustee to pay to said Margaret A. Garber such sum so fixed, and to pay to said Margaret A. Garber, the Guardian of said infants, the remainder of the sum now remaining in said Trustee's hands.

And as in duty bound &c. - Frank C. Howwood, Trustee.

Ordered this 14th day of April A.D. 1886 by the Circuit Court for Frederick sitting in Equity, and by the authority thereof, that the widow, Margaret A. Garber, receive in lieu of dower one seventh of the one hundred and forty-four dollars and eighty-five cents (\$144.85), that is the sum of twenty dollars and sixty-nine cents (\$20.69) and that the trustee pay to her said sum of money at once; and it is further ordered, that said Trustee pay the balance of said fund, that is the sum of one hundred and twenty-four dollars and sixteen cents (\$124.16) over to the said Margaret A. Garber, the guardian of James Irving Rippeau, Estelle V. Rippeau and William V. Rippeau, the said infant defendants.
