This Mortgage made this seventeenth day of February in the year Eighteen Hundred and eighty three by Tilghman Hillary of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witness that whereas the said Tilghman Hillary now stands indebted to the Frederick Town Savings Institution, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, in Frederick County, in the sum of Seventy three Hundred dollars upon a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to the said Frederick Town Savings Institution, or order, six months after date, and for the better securing the payment of the said promissory note at maturity or of any other note or notes that may from time to time hereafter be given in renewal of the same, or for any part thereof, the said Tilghman Hillary has agreed to execute, these presents. Now therefore in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar paid by the said Frederick Town Savings Institution to the said Tilghman Hillary the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Tilghman Hillary do grant in fee simple, to the said Frederick Town Savings Institution, all the following pieces or parts or parcels of land, situate lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland viz: part of a tract called the Reservoir on Hawkins Merry Deep O' Day part of "Golden" and part of Fieldman Manor containing two hundred and fifty acres, two rods and 37 perches of land, more or less, clear of the road, called "Hawkins Mill Road", the parties of said tracts hereby intended to be conveyed being all those parts of said tracts contained within the courses and distances contained within the courses and distances, meters and bounds described and set forth in the deed executed by Thomas Claggett Trustee to the said Tilghman Hillary dated on the second day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty five and recorded in Lib.
