To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

Your Orators Bernard Colliflower, Joseph A. Lemand and Theodore L. Nail  
and Isaac M. Fisher, partners trading under the name, style, and firm of  
Nail, and Fisher, all, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, complain and show.

1. That said John A. Roddy is possessed of certain real estate and personal  
property all of which is situated in Frederick County aforesaid.

2. That being so possessed and being indebted unto the Frederick Town  
Savings Institution of said County in the sum of Sixteen Hundred  
(1,600.00) dollars, he did on the fourth day of May in the year eighteen  
hundred and eighty execute and deliver to said Bank a mortgage to  
secure the payment of said sum of money as will appear by reference to a  
certified copy of said Mortgage herewith filed, as a part hereof and marked  
Exhibit A.

3. That said John A. Roddy having induced your Orator Bernard Colliflower  
and one of the defendants Frederick White to become sureties on a  
testamentary Bond given by him as Executor and filed and recorded  
in the Orphans Court of Frederick County aforesaid, he, the said  
John A. Roddy did to save himself the said sureties on said testamentary  
Bond execute and deliver to them a certain mortgage of indemnity upon his  
real estate in said County which mortgage is duly recorded in Liber A. F. No.  
3, folio 127, one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid, and a  
certified copy whereof is herewith filed marked Exhibit B.

in the sum of Eight Hundred dollars, and unto Hugh F. Roddy in the  
sum of one Hundred and ninety dollars, and unto Addie M. Mully  
in the sum of one Hundred dollars, and unto Mary A. Roddy in the  
sum of two Hundred dollars, and unto Margaret Roddy in the sum  
two Hundred dollars, and unto Martha Ann Roddy in the sum of two  
hundred dollars, and unto Bernard Colliflower in the sum of twenty  
dollars and unto Joseph A. Lemand in the sum of twenty eight  
dollars and seventy cents and unto William J. Roddy in the sum of  
fifty three dollars, and unto Nicholas Baker in the sum of one Hundred and  
five dollars, and unto Nail and Fisher in the sum of two hundred and  
fifty dollars, and unto Simon P. Roddy in the sum of one hundred  
dollars, did to secure the payment of said several sums of money make,  
execute and deliver a certain other mortgage upon said real estate  
and upon certain personal property which is duly recorded in Liber A. F.
