This Indenture Made this fourteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, Between Arnold Linn, John F. Elder, and George Spaulding, Trustees as hereinafter mentioned of Frederick County and State of Maryland, of the one part and John A. Roddy of the County and State aforesaid of the other part - Whereas by a decree of Frederick County Court sitting as a Court of Equity, bearing date the 18th day of February 1850 passed and made in a cause in said Court depending wherein Arnold Linn is Complainant and George Spaulding and others are defendants and numbered 2267 on the Equity Docket of said Court the above named Arnold Linn, John F. Elder and George Spaulding were appointed Trustees & authorized and empowered to make sale of the real estate in said cause mentioned, a part of which is hereafter described and conveyed, and whereas the said Trustees having qualified themselves to act as such trustees
