To the 7th Dec. 7th Ans. She is dead, she died in April 1884 at her mother's house in Frederick County, she did not leave a will, I think, and letters of Administration were granted upon her estate because there was not enough to justify an administration -

To the 8th Dec. 8th Ans. She died unmarried, but left an illegitimate child, who yet survives her, its name is Esta Forrest, its age 4 years, and resides with its grand mother Susan Forrest -

To the 9th Dec. 9th Ans. She was indebted to Michael Kline one of the Plaintiffs in the sum of \$100.00 on a promissory Note - I don't know of her being indebted any other person -

To the 10th Dec. 10th Ans. Look at Exhibit marked A - the name Catharine Forrest written thereon is in the hand writing of the said Catharine Forrest deceased, whom we have been speaking about in this case - I saw her write her name on the said Note, and I signed my name as witness thereto -

To the 11th Dec. 11th Ans. Catharine Forrest got the benefit of the said \$100.00 Michael Kline handed me the said money for her use and I handed it to my wife for her, and then my wife made, made the deed for the land, that \$100.00 formed a part of the consideration expressed in the deed, marked Exhibit No. 6.

To the 12th Dec. 12th Ans. She conveyed it to her sister Catharine Forrest.

To the 13th Dec. 13th Ans. He sold it to Daniel W. Forrest, one of the parties to this suit.

To the 14th Dec. 14th Ans. The said Real estate cannot be divided among the parties interested because it is too small to be divided into so many parts, and because it has but one set of buildings on it.

To the Genl Dec. - I know of nothing further, except to say that if the suit could be settled without any further expense, I think it would be to the benefit of all parties interested -
