9th Q. State who were her heirs, at law?

8th Ans. Her sister Mary Lefevre, so far as I know.

9th Ans. I don't know of any, and I live in the community, only about a mile from the property, and if she did leave any they are unknown.

10th Ans. She did not. I am her Administrator, and she left very little personal estate, in fact not over five dollars worth, while her indebtedness amounts to over a hundred dollars, to Dietrich Jack the Plaintiff.
