7th Qnt. Is the said real estate susceptible of division among the entitled parties without loss and damage thereto and would it be to the interest and advantage of all said parties and especially the infants to have the same sold and if yes; give your reasons therefor?

Testimony

It is not susceptible of division among the parties because it is not properly located for that. I think it would be better for all parties to have the same sold because there is no one there to look after and keep up the property till the infants become of age, and as it is in a good state of cultivation now, it would soon go down if not properly cared for.

5th Qnt. Did the said Joseph Grim Jr. leave a widow surviving him? if yes, state her name and age?
