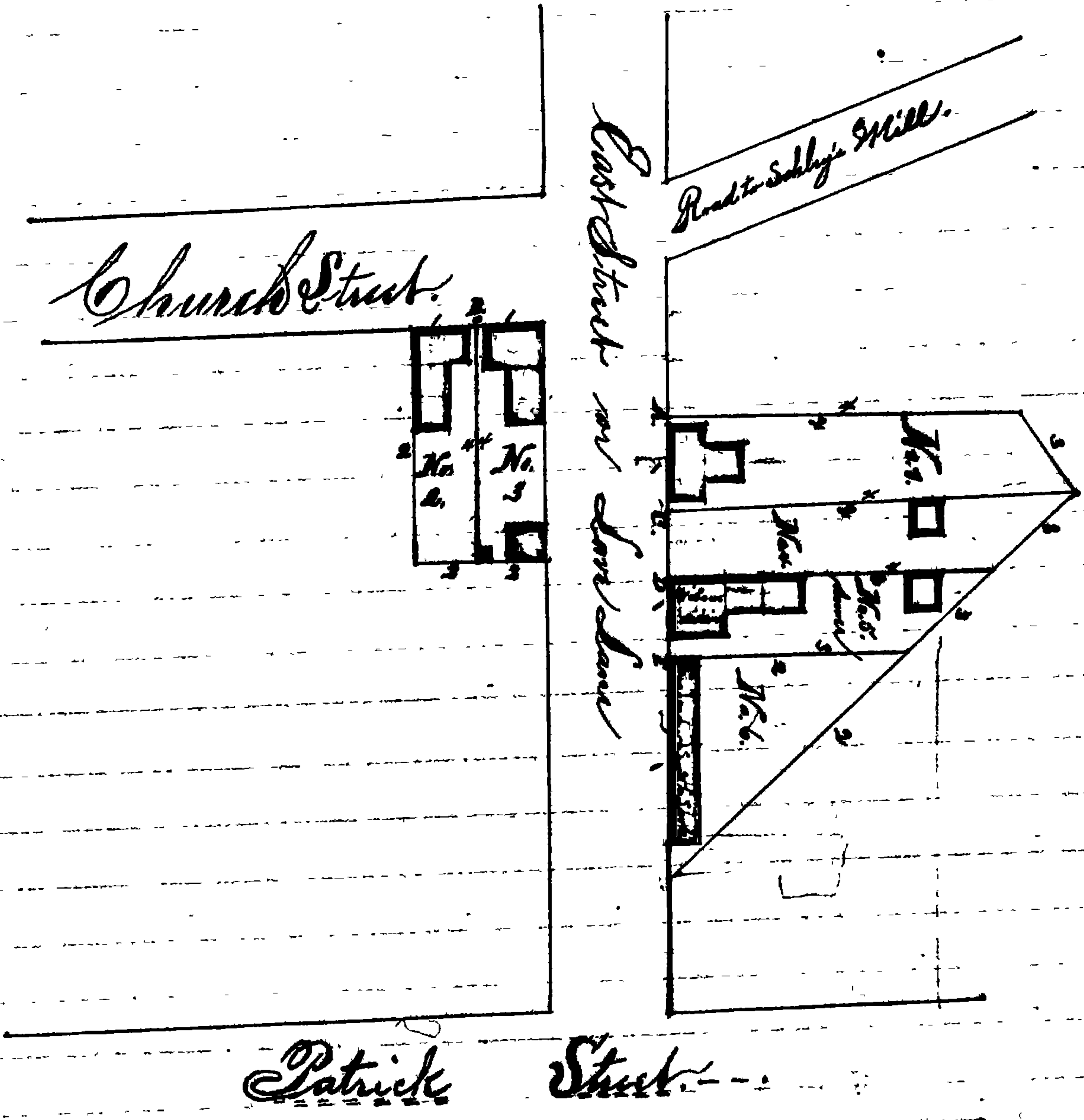
Extract from proceedings in No. 1621 Equity.

To, the Honorable, the Judges, of Frederick County Court.

We, the Subscrib^r, Commissioners appointed in, the annexed Commission, do hereby certify that, after having taken, the oath as required by the said Commission before George Hauser, a Justice of the peace, and for Frederick County, and due notice having been given by us after our qualification as aforesaid to, all, the parties concerned, of the time and place appointed for the execution of said Commission, we met on the premises on the 20th day of November 1838 and did, then, and there, carefully examine, and view the Estate, in the said, Commission, mentioned, when we caused a plat or projection of part of the same to be made out by Thomas H. CNeal, surveyor, who was selected for that purpose which plat or projection, descriptive thereof is hereto annexed. We then proceeded to lay off, the widows dower, and after due deliberation, signed to her, as the one third of said estate mentioned in the said Commission, the two story Brick dwelling house in which she at present resides the lot or portion of ground and other improvements attached thereto, and which lot and premises will be seen designated, on the said plat as No. 5, and by the accompanying explanations, marked, as beginning at D and running thence with the lines numbered 1, 2, 3, and 4 to D, and also the vacant lot adjoining and lying North of the above described lot, and premises, and marked on the plat, as No. 4, and designated in the explanations accompanying the same as beginning at C, and running thence with the lines numbered 1, 2, 3 and 4 to C embracing all the improvements thereon, all of which your Commissioners herewith return to your Honorable Court, Signed under our hands and seals, this 20th day of November 1838. — John Rigney *[Signature]*
