The Bill in this case is filed to procure a decree for the sale of certain Real Estate situated in Frederick City.

1. The Bill states that Jonathan Eder, departed this life sometime in eighteen hundred and thirty seven intestate possessed of considerable real estate, leaving a widow but no children surviving him.

2. That the heirs of said decedent were his brothers and sisters and their descendants of the whole blood.

3. That his widow instituted proper proceedings for the assignment of her dower was duly laid off, and assigned in Equity cause No. 1421.

4. That said widow died a few days ago.

5. That said Jonathan Eder left surviving him a brother Thomas Eder, a brother William Eder, a brother Davina Eder, and the daughters of a deceased sister, to wit, Louisa Shope and Rebecca Lane.

6. That said Thomas Eder has since departed this life leaving him the following children, (1) Augustus L. Eder, a son (whose wife's name is Annis M. Eder) (2) Isabella Ent, a daughter (whose husband's name is Charles J. Ent) (3) John M. Eder, a son, (whose wife's name is Ella Eder) (4) Annis C. Mann, a daughter (whose husband's name is Charles B. Mann) (5) a daughter who married John Welfley, and after having issue born, died leaving said husband, and child surviving, and which child shortly thereafter also died leaving its said father surviving. (7) That said William Eder departed this life leaving surviving him the following heirs, to wit, (1) Louisa Eder, a daughter, (2) Ann E. Bantz, a daughter, (whose husband's name is Marion Bantz) (3) Alice Schinner, a daughter, (whose husband's name is George B. Schinner) (4) Helen M. Eder, a daughter.

8. That said Davina Eder departed this life beyond the limits of the State of Maryland, and leaving surviving him, but their names and places of residence are wholly unknown to the plaintiffs who also ignorant as to the ages of said children.
