To the Honorable the Judges of said Court: Yours, of said Court
Your Obedt. and Obedt. Complaining Jay -

1. That Daniel Rinehart late, of Frederick County recently, died intestate
seized and possessed, of Valuable Real Estate lying partly in Frederick
County, and partly in Carroll County, consisting of a Tract of land
containing thirty eight acres, More or less, Situated in Frederick County,
and a Tract of three acres and twenty-four perches, more or less,
situated in Carroll County, both of which are described in a
Deed from David Rinehart & others to said David Rinehart,
a copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1, and
which, with all other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken
as part of this Bill of Complaint, as fully as if here inserted
in words and figures; also, a tract of land lying partly in Frederick
County and partly in Carroll County containing One hundred and thirty
two acres three rods and fifteen perches of land, described in a Deed
from David Rinehart & others to said David Rinehart, a copy of which
is filed herewith Marked Exhibit No. 2, all of said tracts being contiguous
and containing in the aggregate One hundred and Seventy four
acres of land more or less -

2. That said Daniel Rinehart was also, at the time of his
death seized and possessed of an undivided One fifth interest,
as heir at law of Israel Rinehart dec'd in, and to a certain
Marble Quarry Lot, Situated in Frederick County and containing
Two Acres and Twenty eight Perches of land, More or less,
being the same land described in four separate deeds of Conveyance
to said Israel Rinehart a copy of one of which is filed herewith
with Marked Exhibit No. 3. -

3. That said Daniel Rinehart died leaving the Plaintiff Rebecca
L. Rinehart as his widow and the following as his children and
only heirs at law - viz -

1 - The Plaintiff Mary V. Jumburn, wife of Willis Jumburn.

2 - The Plaintiff S. Olivia Rinehart -

3 - That Plaintiff Florence Jennie Engle, wife of John D. Engle.

4 - Joseph S. Rinehart.

5. Thomas M. Rinehart, who is married, and whose wife is
named Elizabeth Rinehart.

6 - Lucy N. Rinehart.

7 - Grace S. Rinehart.
