At the request of Daniel Rinehart the following Deed was Recorded June 7th 1873.

This Deed made this Twenty Second, day, of February in the Year of our Lord One Thousand, Eight Hundred, and Seventy Three by us David Rinehart & Hannah Rinehart his wife, of Frederick County State of Maryland, and Israel C. Rinehart & Lucinda Rinehart his wife of Maryland, and William H. Rinehart of Carroll County State, aforesaid, and Evan Rinehart of the City of Baltimore, and State, aforesaid, and Ephraim Rinehart, and Augustus Rinehart his wife, of Troy Miami County State, of Ohio: Witnesseth That in consideration of the sum of Five thousand and Seven Hundred, and Seventy Three dollars, and Thirty one cents, We the said David Rinehart, and Hannah Rinehart his wife, Israel C. Rinehart, and Lucinda Rinehart his wife, William H. Rinehart, Evan Thomas Rinehart, and Ephraim Rinehart, and Augustus Rinehart his wife, do hereby grant unto Daniel Rinehart of Frederick County and State, aforesaid, all of the following named, and, described two tracts, or parcels of Land, Being and Lying hereinafter, described parcel (38a) in Frederick County State of Maryland, and the other or second, described, parcel, 3 acres & 24 perches, in Carroll County and State, aforesaid - Beginning for a description of the outlines of the first parcel, at a stone planted on the 8th. Line given in the Deed from David Rinehart to which Switzer, dated December 26th 1867 and running thence, reversing, and bounding, on said line, allowing for difference of Magnetic Declination 1 1/2 North, one and a half Degrees East Forty two and a half perches still reversing said line Correcting the courses and Distances as by a survey, thereof, made in October, 1868 by David St. Vaill, 2nd South Eighty three and half Degrees East, twenty seven Perches, 3rd North from, and a quarter Degree West Eighty five, and a quarter perches to a stone on the last line given in the Deed from Joel Wright et al, to David Rinehart Dated December 14th, 1866 & bounding, thence, allowing, as aforesaid, 4th. South Eighty three and a half, Degrees East Thirty Nine, and a quarter perches. Thence 5th. South from, and three quarter Degree East One hundred, and Twenty Two perches to a line stone at the Beginning given in the Deed from Israel Rinehart to Israel C. Rinehart dated February 8th, 1869, & thence, reversing the lines of said, to include a Watering place, therein named, and, thereby Excluded 6th. South fifteen & three quarters Degrees West Eight tenths of a perch 7th. South four and three quarters Degrees East Twenty One and a half perches 8th. South forty seven, and a half Degrees East Two and nine tenths perches. 9th. North Eighty one Degree East Four, and a half perches. 10th. South fifteen Degrees East One, and Six tenths perches, 11th. South Sixty one, and, three quarter Degrees West

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
