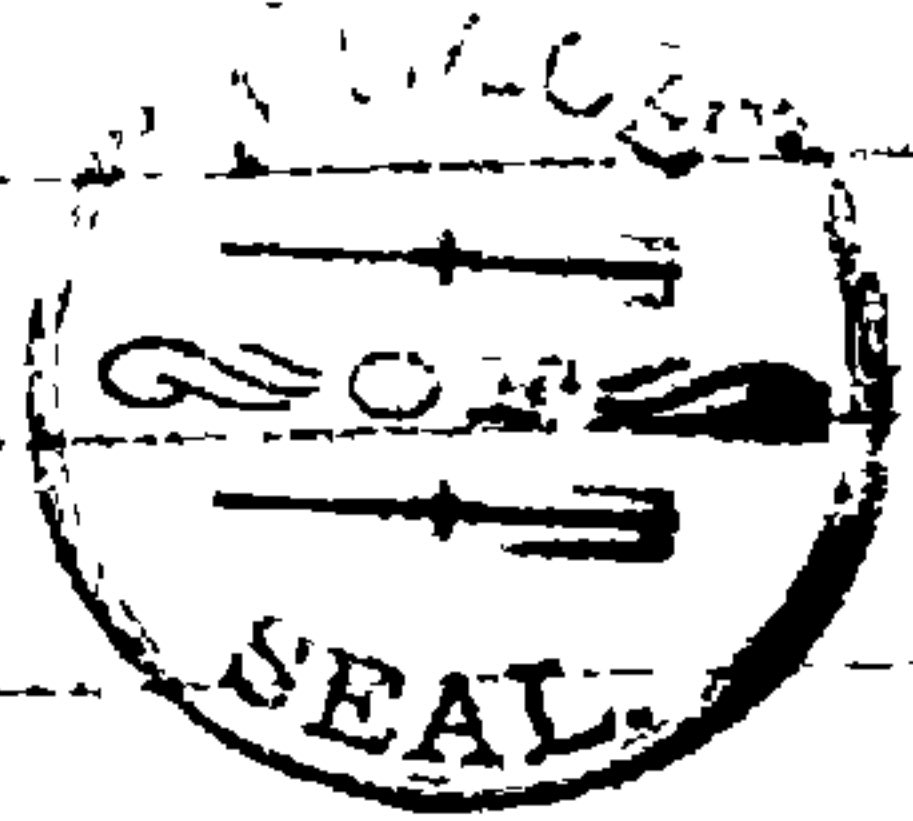

At the request of Israel Rinehart the following Deed is Recorded May 13th 1883 to-wit:

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of April in the year of our Lord 1833 between Aaron Hedges and Catharine Hedges his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Israel Rinehart of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that they the said Aaron Hedges and Catharine Hedges for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars current money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said Israel Rinehart before the receipt whereof they the said Aaron Hedges and Catharine Hedges do hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof do hereby acquit, exonerate and discharge the said Israel Rinehart his heirs, executors and administrators they the said Aaron Hedges and Catharine Hedges have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Israel Rinehart his heirs and assigns, all their the said Aaron Hedges and Catharine Hedges undivided and fourth part of the following described part of a land called The Quarry on Street in Neck situate lying and being in Frederick County aforesaid, and known by the name of the Quarry Lot. Beginning for said part at a stone planted in the public road leading from Haught Church to Franklin's Tavern and at the end of a line drawn North eighty degrees West nine perches from the end of fifty six perches on the first line of the deed from William W. Parfumer and others heirs of John Orr late of Frederick County deceased to Israel Rinehart and running thence South three and a quarter degrees East eighteen perches to a stone South fifty two and a quarter degrees West six and a quarter perches to a stone, South
