and paid out by them.

18. That the Executors aforesaid have wholly refused to pay any part of your orators, or the other unpaid Creditors Claims aforesaid, or render unto them any account of the aforesaid Estate in their hands.

19. That your Orator is informed, and believes that the Personal Estate and Proceeds of sale of Real Estate, which came into the hands of said Executors were not sufficient to discharge all the just debts of the said John Hagan deceased, owing at the time of his death, and that the same now in the hands of his Executors and Trustees under his Will ought to be applied to the payment of your Orator, and the other unpaid creditors of John Hagan deceased, so far as the same will extend, and that any deficiency ought to be supplied by a sale of all, or such part, as may be necessary of the remaining Real Estate of the aforesaid deceased Debtor.

20. And your Orator Prays for the following Relief:

(1) That an account may be taken under the direction of this Court of said debts, so as aforesaid, due to your Orator, and of all other Debts which were owing by said Testator at the time of his Death, and which still remain unpaid, and also of all estate and effects of said Testator received by the said Trustees and Executors aforesaid. (2) That said estate and effects may be applied in due course of Administration in payment of the debts of the Testator due your Orator, and all the other creditors who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit. (3) That said Real Estate of said John Hagan deceased, or so much thereof as may be sold for the payment of so much of the aforesaid debts as may remain unsatisfied after a proper application of the estate and effects in the hands of the Executors aforesaid.

(4) That your Orator may have such other and further relief as he may require.

21. And your Orator prays for the following Provisions: (1) A writ of subpoena directed to the said Noah Barber, John L. Hagan and Kate Hagan, his wife, Marshal Kane Hagan, Helasene E. Hagan, an infant, John Clifford Hagan, an infant, Eugene Hagan, infant, Thomas Denton Hagan, an infant, Ralph Ritchie Hagan, an infant, and Clara Kate Hagan, an infant, all of Frederick County, and to the said Eugene Hagan and Rosa Hagan, his wife (an infant), and William Hagan, and Elizabeth Smith, all of Baltimore City, Maryland, and to said Frank Hagan and Amanda Hagan, his wife, and Washington L. Hagan, an infant, and Mollie W. Hagan, an infant, all of Washington County, commanding them and each of them to be and appear, either in person or by Solicitor, in this Court, on or before a certain day, to be named therein, to show cause, if any they or any of them have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
