This Deed made this fourteenth day of April in the Year Eighteen Hundred and Eighty Three by Mr. E. A. Hagan of Baltimore City, State of Maryland, Witnesseth, whereas John Hagan late of Frederick County, deceased, by his last Will and Testament duly probated and recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills of Frederick County did bequeath unto the said Mr. E. A. Hagan the sum of One Thousand Dollars to be paid to him at the end of six years from his decease by John C. Hagan, and made the said Legacy of One Thousand Dollars a charge and lien on the lands devised to the said John C. Hagan as will appear by reference to the said Will and Testament of John Hagan recorded in the Office of Register of Wills of Frederick Co. Now therefore in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by Noah Bowler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, & the said Mr. E. A. Hagan being over the age of Twenty One years do hereby bargain, sell, assign and set over unto the said Noah Bowler, all my right, title, and interests in, and to, the aforesaid Legacy so bequeathed to me by the said John Hagan, death the said Legacy being the sum of One Thousand Dollars, with full power to demand, collect, receive and receipt for the same when the same shall become due and payable interest and principal according to the provisions of the said last Will and Testament of the said John Hagan, death. And the said Mr. E. A. Hagan covenants that he has not sold said Legacy nor any part thereof, nor otherwise encumbered the same. And the said Mr. E. A. Hagan do hereby authorize, order and direct the said John C. Hagan to pay over to the said Noah Bowler the said Legacy of One Thousand Dollars, and his receipt, or deed of Release shall be a full discharge and release of said Legacy to the said John C. Hagan. Witness my hand and seal.
