To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County
in Equity. The Petitioners of Sarah A. White, and George W. Dean, Adminis-
trators of the Goods and Chattels of William White, late of Frederick County,
deceased respectfully shows to Your Honors.

1st. That a certain John Hagan in his life time, was indebted to
William White in his life time upon several single Bills, as follows

1st. A Note under Seal Executed by John Hagan, and John Hagan -
dated on the 27th day of April, 1875, payable to said William White
or order six months after date for One Hundred and Fifty Dollars
\$150 with interest from date. Upon which Note payments have been made
of interest by the said John Hagan in his life time and by Noah
Bowles one of his Executors - since the death of said John Hagan
as by reference to said Note herewith Exhibited will appear.

2. A Seal Note Executed by John Hagan dated on the 21st day
of December 1875, payable to William White or order six months
after date for the sum of Two Hundred and One Dollars \$201 -
with interest from date - Upon which Note the interest has been paid
to Dec. 21st 1877, as will appear by credit on said Note.

3. A Seal Note Executed by John Hagan bearing date on the 15th day
of January 1878, payable to William White or order for the sum of Two Hundred
and Thirty One Dollars and Forty Seven Cents \$231.47, with interest from
date. Upon which Note the interest has been paid to April 15th 1879
as will appear by credit on said Note. All of which Notes, are filed, as Exhibits
to this Petition, and are prayed to be taken as part thereof.

4th - Your Petitioners further state, and charge that, all of said Notes have
been due and payable long since, and that all of said Notes are due, and
owing except the payments thereon, as herein before stated.

5th That William White Obligor in said Notes, died intestate, died intestate
in the Year 1854, and that letters of Administration, on his Estate, were
granted by the Orphans Court, of Frederick County State of Maryland
to your Petitioners Sarah A. White and George W. Dean, as will appear
by certified copies of Letters of Exemplification herewith filed, and
prayed to be taken as part of this Petition.

6th. That a certain John Murdock, on the 12th day of May 1887 filed
his Bill of Complaint in Your Honorable Court, charging that
the Personal Estate, of the said, decedent John Hagan, and also the
proceeds of the Real Estate, sold by the Executors of the said, decedent
were insufficient to pay the just debts of the said John Hagan, and praying
that the Real Estate of the said, decedent may be sold for the purpose
of paying the debt due to the said Complainant and all other creditors
of the said John Hagan, decd. As will appear by the proceedings in
No. 5403 Equity, in Your Honorable Court.

7th Your Petitioners charge that the said John Hagan is largely indebted
to the Estate of their decedent William White on the Notes aforesaid - - -
