Noah Bowler, a Single of Lawful Age, produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn, and Examined, deposes & says as follows:

1st Q. State your name, age, residence and occupation.

A. Noah Bowler; Age 67 Years; Frederick, Maryland; Occupation Atty at Law.

2nd Q. Did you know John Hagan late of Frederick County, if dead, is he living or dead, if dead, when and where did he die, and did he die testate or intestate?

A. I did know him; he is dead; he died in Frederick County, about January 19th 1883; he died Testate.

3rd Q. Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit No. 1. and state whether or not the same is a copy of the Last Will and Testament of said John Hagan, deceased?

A. I look at it; it is a certified copy of said Will, and a true and correct copy thereof.

Testimony.

4th Q. Do you know John L. Hagan, Frank T. Hagan, and Eugene Hagan, Sons of said John Hagan, deceased, and devisees mentioned in his said Will, if yes, state their ages and residences, and if any of them are married, state the name of their wives?

A. I know them - They are all adults, and all married - John L. lives in Frederick County & his wife's name is Kate - Frank T. lives in Stacks County & his wife's name is Amanda - Eugene lives in Baltimore City & his wife's name is Rose - The wives are all Adults.

5th Q. Deponent Elizabeth Smith, a devisee named in the will of said John Hagan, dec'd. If yes, state whether or not she is single or married? If married give her present name, and the name of her husband, and state the age & residence of each?

A. I know Elizabeth Smith the devisee - She is married now to the name of Pratt; both Adults & now live in Montgomery County.

6th Q. Do you know William Hagan - mentioned in the last Will of said John Hagan, dec'd. if yes state his age and residence.

A. I did not know him personally, I know of him. I know of him he is the Son of Mrs. Smith now Mrs. Pratt & the Grand Son of the Testator & that he is of age. I have had dealings with him through his Attorneys, as is shown by Exhibit No. 4. filed in this case - I do not know his present residence, it was formerly Baltimore.

7th Q. Are you acquainted with the Hand-writing of the said John Hagan, dec'd. if yes, look at Exhibits A. B. C. D. E. F. G. H. I. J. now shown you and state whether or not the signatures therein are each in the proper and genuine hand-writing of said John Hagan, dec'd.?

A. I am acquainted with Hand-writing - I look at Exhibits from A. to J. inclusive & the signatures thereby are in the hand-writing of said John Hagan, dec'd.

8th Q. State whether or not all the real estate devised to be sold by this Executor? State all your knowledge fully herein?

A. It has all been sold. I am one of the Executors - - -

9th Q. State whether or not the proceeds of said real estate so sold by his executors and the proceeds of personal Estate were together sufficient to pay all the just debts owing by said John Hagan, at the time of his death?

A. They are not - There was a considerable deficiency -

10th Q. State whether or not you and your co-executor or either of you have in hands any of the funds arising from the sale of said real
