This Indenture made this twenty third day of February in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred, and Fifty-Five, between John Dufford, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Trustee as hereinafter mentioned, of the one part, and John Hagan, of the said County and State, of the other part: Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County aforesaid, sitting as a Court of Equity, bearing date on the 21st day of February 1855, and passed in a cause in the said Court, depending wherein the said John Hagan, and a certain Michael P. Hagan and William Keller, were Complainants, and a certain Stephen Hagan, David Schaefer, and Nancy his wife, George Smith, Henry Hagan, Robert Ringer,
