

No 5304 Equity.

"Fieldera Manor" and part of Salisbury Plains helped, beginning at the end of 25 paces on the 4th line of the deed from Charles St. Johnson to Joseph Heigheimer, dated 22nd of October 1826 for 50 Acres, and running thence by and with said deed reversed three courses N. 18 1/2° W. 25 paces. S. 58° W. 22 paces. N. 78° W. 37 1/2 paces then S. 84° W. 72 1/2 paces to the middle of the Turnpike road, then by and with the middle of said road S. 75° E. 1 1/2 paces. N. 75° E. 16 paces. N. 60° E. 10 paces N. 33° E. 20 paces. N. 71° E. 25 paces S. 78° E. 24 paces then N. 10° E. 29 paces to the beginning containing 20 Acres more or less. The 2nd being lots 2, 3 & 6 lying on the South side of the Turnpike, conveyed to Peter Hagan by Richard Potts by deed dated 20th May 1840, being part of "Fieldera Manor" and part of Salisbury Plains helped: Beginning for lot No. 2, at the end of the 2nd line of Richard Potts deed to James Fields for Lot No. 1, part of said land, and running thence N. 75° W. 8 paces. N. 24° W. 40 paces to the middle of the Turnpike Road, then with said Road S. 78° E. 8 paces to the end of the 2nd line of Lot No. 1, then with said line reversed S. 24° E. 40 paces to the beginning containing two acres more or less. Beginning for a Lot No. 3, at the end of the 1st line of Lot No. 2, aforesaid, and running thence N. 78° W. 5 paces N. 24° W. 40 paces to the middle of the Turnpike, then with said road S. 78° E. 8 paces to the end of the 2nd line of Lot No. 2, then with said lot reversed S. 24° E. 40 paces to the beginning, containing two Acres, more or less. Beginning for Lot No. 6 in the middle of the Turnpike Road, it being the end of the 2nd line of Lot No. 3, and running thence by and with said 2nd line reversed S. 24° E. 40 paces to the end of the 1st line thereof, then N. 78° W. 4 paces. N. 24° W. 40 paces to the Turnpike aforesaid, then with said road to the beginning containing One Acre, more or less. The 3rd parcel aforesaid being part of Lot No. 1. part of "Fieldera Manor" and part of Salisbury Plains helped, being the same lot which was on the 14th June 1833, conveyed by James Fields to Thomas Mayberry for one acre, it being also the same lot conveyed to Peter Hagan by Henry Niscliff on the 8th December 1841, beginning at a stone on the South side of the Turnpike, it being on the 5th and last line of Lot No. 4, it being also the beginning of said Lot 1, then with the 1st line thereof S. 24° E. 11 1/2 paces. then leaving said line and running across Lot No. 1. N. 67° W. 12 paces to a stone on the 3rd line of Lot No. 1, and with said line N. 24° W. 13 1/2 paces to the Turnpike, it being the end of the said 3rd line, then with the 4th line of said Lot No. 1. S. 88° E. 12 ending in the Turnpike S. 24° E. 2 paces to the beginning containing one acre, together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, ways, water courses, rights, members, advantages, privileges and appurtenances unto the said several Tracts, parts of Tracts or parcels of land hereinbefore described, belonging or in any wise appertaining - To have and to hold the said hereinbefore described Real Estate and premises with the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said John Hagan his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use of the said John Hagan, his heirs and assigns forever, freed, cleared, and discharged from all claim and demand whatever of the parties complainants, and defendants in the cause aforesaid -
