The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answers,
Exhibits Testimony and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is thereupon, this 10th day of February in the year eighteen hundred and
Eighty-Eight by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and
by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the lands and
premises mentioned in these proceedings, or so much thereof, as may be necessary
for the payment of the debts of John Hagan deceased and the costs and expenses
of this Suit, be sold, and that Clayton O. Keady, Charles V. S. Loy and William
Wilcox of Frederick County, be, and they are hereby appointed Trustees to make
the said Sales, and that the course and manner of their proceedings shall be as
as follows: They shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court a Bond to the
State of Maryland, executed by them with a surety, or sureties, to be approved
by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Ten Thousand Dollars,
conditioned for the faithful performance of the Trust reposed in them by this
Decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order, or decree in
