Var.$ to wit: $^1 S 10^{\circ} W. 35 ps.$ to a stone now planted, then along the New Public Road reversing the line of Lot No. 2 to wit: $^2 S 50^{\circ} E. 27.11$ to a stone now planted; $^3 S 42^{\circ} E. 10.56 ps.$ to a stone now planted; $^4 S 51^{\circ} E. 21.16 ps.$ to a stone now planted, then by lines of division with Lots Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10 to wit: $^5 N. 30^{\circ} E. 41 ps.$ to a Span Oak Tree; $^6 N. 22^{\circ} E. 42 ps.$ to intersect the 31st line of aforesaid tract at the end of $47.64 ps.$ then reversing said 31st line and binding thence, allowing $3^{\frac{1}{2}} E.
