Lot No. 10. Wood Land, mostly. Beginning at the end of 19.4 feet on 6th line of Strawberry Lot No. 6, it also being at the end of the 3rd line of Lot No. 9, then with said 6th line of Lot No. 6 to-wit; $N. 22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E. 23.16$ ps. to a stone now planted, at the end of 47.64, on the 3rd line of the whole tract called The Resurvey on Gilboa and with said line allowing $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.
