At the request of Philip M. Engelbrecht the following Deed was recorded April 9th 1856.

Exhibit No. 2. This Indenture made this 2^d day of April in the year of Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty Six between William S. Bennett of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the first part, and Philip M. Engelbrecht of the County and State aforesaid of the second part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars current money, by the said party hereto of the second part, to the to the party of the first part hereto, in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part, hath granted bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released conveyed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff, release convey, and confirm unto the said Philip M. Engelbrecht his heirs and assigns forever, the southern one-half part of all that lot or parcel of ground, adjoining Frederick City in Frederick County, Maryland, at the South end of Market Street extended, and on the west side thereof. Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the South east corner of the whole lot as conveyed by Jacob Markell to the said William S. Bennett, and running North on Market Street seventeen feet six inches, to the centre of the House erected on said lot, thence in a westerly line one hundred and sixty feet, thence South seventeen feet six inches to the South-west corner of the conveyance from Jacob Markell to the said William S. Bennett; thence in a straight line to the place of beginning on Market Street; it being the Southern one half part of all that lot of ground which was conveyed by Jacob Markell to the said William S. Bennett by deed bearing date on the 21st day of September in the year 1855 and recorded in Libr E. S. No. 7, folios 6600. One of the Land Records of Frederick County - with the privilege of an alley ten feet wide
