At the request of John Groshon the following Deed was
 recorded 27 June 1845 -

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of March in the Year of our
 Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred & Forty-five between George Clem & Matilda
 Clem his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland of the part & John
 Groshon as Trustee of the County and State aforesaid of the other part.
 Witnesseth, that the said George Clem & Matilda Clem, his wife for & in
 consideration of the sum of One Hundred & Twenty-five Dollars current
 Money of the United States to them the said George Clem & Matilda
