At the Request of William Smith, the following Deed is Recorded Sept 9th 1878.

This Deed made this ninth day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Eight by Francis T. Shroder, and Jane M. Shroder his wife, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred Dollars, the said Francis T. Shroder and Jane M. Shroder his wife, do grant unto William Smith of the aforesaid County and State all that lot or parcel of land, situate in Buckeye District, Frederick County, it being a part of the Tract of Land conveyed by Edward T. Helt and Wife to Jacob Basford, on the thirtieth day of April 1867, and Recorded in Liber D. S. B. No. 1 folio 290, and conveyed by Jacob Basford and wife to Francis T. Shroder, on the twenty third day of February 1872, and recorded in Liber C. M. No. 8 folio 86, by reference thereto will more fully appear, the Lot or parcel of ground hereby conveyed is, contained in the following meters & bounds; Beginning for the outlines, at a stone planted, at the end of 47 1/2 perches on the 48th line of Addition to "Cannon" of which this is a part, and then running with the said line South 19 1/2 degrees West 81 perches Woods, or O Beck's lot thence with the said lot South 37 degrees East 33 perches, to the Northern limits of of the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road, thence with the limits of the said Road North 68 1/2 degrees East 40 perches North 50 degrees East to intersect Lewis Specht's Land, until it reaches the land of Joshua & Michael thence with the South Western line of J. C. Michael's lot to a corner, thence North 80 1/4 degrees East 9 1/2 perches to the Public Road leading from Doub's Switch to Point of Rocks Road and with it North 20 degrees West 7 1/4 perches North 13 1/2 degrees West 28 2/10 perches to a Stone planted in the Middle of the said Road thence with John Belts Lot 61 1/2 degrees West 16 3/4 perches thence with the Western Line of John Belts Lot to the place of beginning containing twenty six acres of Land more or less.
