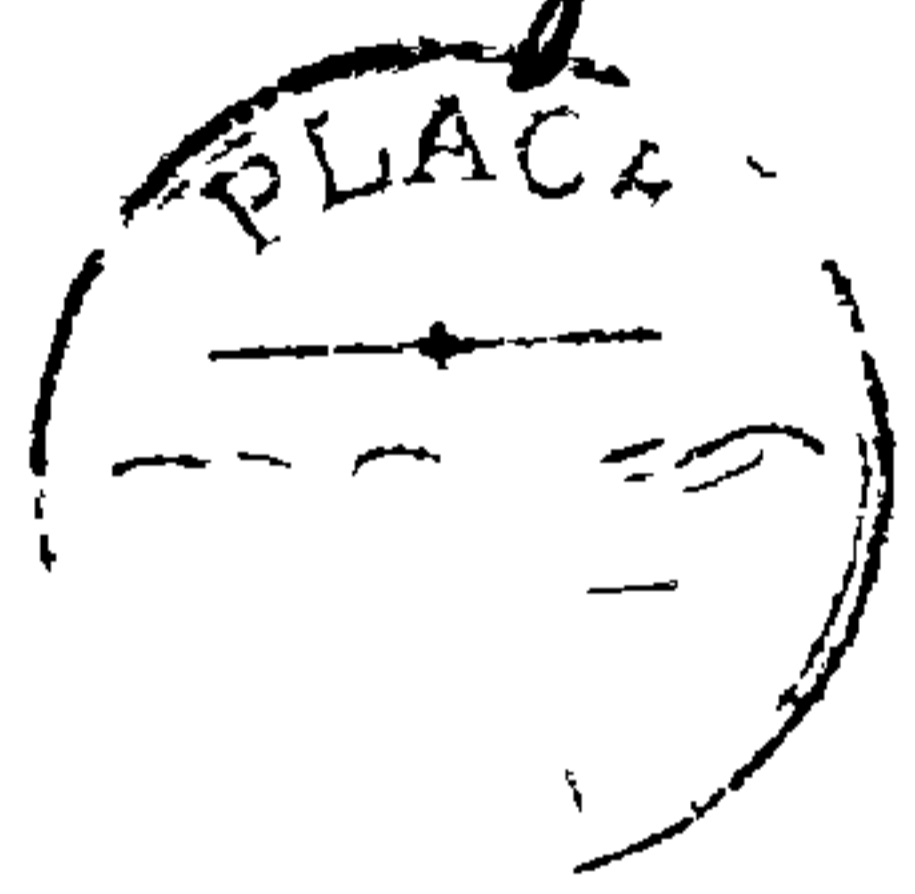

Commissioner's Return

Know ye, that we have, pursuant to an order of our Circuit Court, in Equity, this day passed in a cause in our said Court depending between Othetta T. Ramsburg, Plaintiff, and John St. Ramsburg and others Defendants, being No. 5270 Equity on the Equity Docket of said Court, fully authorized and empowered you, or any three of you, to enter upon, walk over, survey, locate and lay off, One-third part of the Real Estate whereof Josiah Ramsburg, late of Frederick County, died seized, and which is described in these proceedings, consisting of a Tract of land in said Frederick County, containing in the whole One Hundred and Seventy nine acres, One Rood, and twenty-seven square perches of land, more or less, being the same Real Estate which was conveyed to Josiah Ramsburg by Hannah Owings, Charles S. Owings et al by deed dated March 28th, 1871, and duly Recorded in Lib. C. M. No. 7, folio 3480, One of the Land Records of Frederick County, and being fully described in a certified copy of said deed filed as Exhibit No. 1, in the aforesaid Cause No. 5270 Equity, as and for the dowry of the said Petitioner, Mary A. Ramsburg, in the said Real Estate, and that you make out, or cause to be made out, a plat and certificate of the said real estate, and an accurate description of the one-third part or dowry so laid out; and when you shall have so done, you, or such of you as shall act, are to certify and return unto this Court
