to this cause, so that one fourth part thereof shall be allotted to the said Emily  
Shipley, one other fourth part thereof to the said Martha C. Addison, and other  
fourth part thereof to the children of Mary Ellen England, as Tenants in common,  
and one other fourth part thereof to Thomas A. Smith for life, and after  
his death to the children of Ann Rebecca Smith, as Tenants in common  
And to enable this court to make the said partition it is further adjudged,  
ordered and decreed that a commission issue in the usual form to Jacob Walker,  
George W. Smith, Eugene L. Dew, John S. Best and Joseph Krouse of Frederick  
county, authorizing them or any four or three of them to enter upon, mark  
out and survey the said Land, and to divide the same into four equal parts  
having regard to quantity and quality, whereof one of said parts shall be  
allotted to the said Emily C. Shipley, One of said equal parts shall be  
allotted to said Martha C. Addison, One of said equal parts shall be  
allotted to the children of Mary Ellen England, as tenants in common,  
and one of said equal parts shall be allotted to said Thomas A. Smith  
for life and to the children of Ann Rebecca Smith as Tenants in common  
after the death of said Thomas A. Smith, and that the said Commissioners  
make out or cause to be made out a plat and certificate of said land  
and of the division thereof, with the beginning and courses, and an accurate  
description of the said estate, and of the parts thereof, and to the said  
commissioners be authorized by the commission to call upon the parties  
to produce all such deeds, writings and monuments, relating to the  
said estate, as may be in their power, and also to examine and  
take the deposition of witnesses relating to the matters in question  
as they may think fit; all which proceedings, of the commissioners together  
with the plats, descriptions and Documentary or other evidence made, produced, or  
taken by them to be returned by them with their commission, to this Court.
