that in consideration of Love and Affection for their daughter Annis Eliza wife of Joseph S Emmett do grant unto her of said County and State all that lot or parcel of ground situate and lying in Carroll County and State aforesaid being part of a tract of land resurveyed and called prosperity and conveyed by deed to the said D. P Saylor by Joshua Smith, Trustee for the Sale of the Real Estate of George H. Karsche late of Frederick County deceased bearing date April 24th 1854 and recorded in Liber E S No 5. folio 40, 41, & 42 One of the Land Records of Frederick County and State aforesaid Beginning for the same at a small Sycamore Tree standing on the west side of the road leading from Woodboro to Keys School House, and also at the end of the 3rd line of a tract or a part of the same lands conveyed by the said D P Saylor and wife to their Daughter Margaret Ellen born and running thence by dividing lines now made west 14 per ending on Shellys Rock on hill north of Double Pipe Creek thence North 72 1/2 West 34 per inside of field, thence north 86 1/2 west 23 perches to edge of hollow near fence, thence down said hollow crossing it diagonally South 34 1/2 West 8 per. ending on located Rail Road tract thence South 84 1/2 West 18 per to a stake in bottom, thence crossing said creek South 4 West 13 1/2 per. to a large Shell bark Tree standing on the south bank of said creek and just below water fence thence North 89 1/2 West 18 per. to stake on south bank of said creek thence South 14 West 240 perches to a stone corresponding with the one called for at the end of the 31st line on the Resurvey aforesaid and with the lines thereof as given in the deed from said Joshua Smith trustee and with the 32nd line thereof, North 66 West 49 1/2 per to a stone standing near a large White Oak Tree marked with twelve notches, and standing on the South Bank of Double Pipe Creek thence North 76 West 20 per. to a stone standing near two marked Maples on the south bank of said creek, North 89 West 18 1/2 per to a stone at the end
