This Deed made this twentieth day of March Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-four by Joshua Longman of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Executor, of George Longman late of Frederick County, deceased, Witnesseth that whereas by authority vested in me by the Last Will and Testament of said deceased, and by an order from the Orphans Court of Frederick County, to all the Lands belonging to the deceased, and have sold part of the same to Pointon Stottlemeyer for the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, who has fully paid the purchase money. Now therefore in consideration of the above recited premises, I the said Joshua Longman, Executor, of George Longman Dec. do grant in fee simple unto Pointon Stottlemeyer of Frederick County, State of Maryland, State of Maryland, all the following described Lot of Ground situated in Frederick County, and State of Maryland, and being part of a Tract of Land, called "Comrade Travels by Night" Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed, at the end of the 8th line of the Deed from John D. and Daniel Harshman to Cornelia Harshman for 107 Acres, and 9 fs. and running thence N. 63° W 44 fs to the end of 45 1/2 fs on the 11th line of said Deed and with said Deed reversed three courses, viz. S 26° W 45 1/2 fs. N 75° E 23 1/2 fs. N. 68° E. 36 1/2 fs. to the place of beginning, and containing Six Acres of Land more or less - excepting thereout one half Acre of Land sold for a School House Lot, bordering on the Public Road, which leaves remaining five Acres and one half acre of Land more or less.
