This Indenture made this 14th day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Fifty-five, by and between George Smith of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the one part, and Henry Korster of the County and State aforesaid of the other part - Witnesseth, that whereas Jacob Hart of the County and State aforesaid, being indebted to sundry persons and corporations, by judgments, notes, and open accounts, and being desirous of distributing the proceeds of the sale of his Property among his Creditors, according to their several and respective claims, the said Jacob Hart hath in conjunction with his wife Mary Hart executed, a deed bearing date the 13th day of December 1854, recorded in Liber E & No 5 folio 326, 327 & 328. One of the Land Records of Frederick County conveyed all the real and personal estate of them the said Jacob Hart and Mary Hart his wife to the said George Smith, in trust, for the purposes therein mentioned. Now this Indenture witnesseth, that the said George Smith for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred dollars, Current Money, to him in hand paid, by the said Henry Korster, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said George Smith doth hereby acknowledge hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, alien, enfeoff, release, convey and confirm unto the said Henry Korster his heirs and assigns forever all that Lot or parcel of ground with two Brick-Houses thereon situated on the North side of Patrick Street, Fredericktown in the County & State aforesaid
