

At the request of Noah Cramer the following Deed was recorded May 24th 1865 --- 

This Deed made this third day of April in the Year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty-five by us Christian Kinebunner & Phebe his wife, Witnefsath, that in consideration of Thirteen Hundred, fifty-five & five eighths dollars, we the said Christian and Phebe Kinebunner do grant to Noah Cramer, the following, described, parcel of land lying in Frederick County, Maryland, being a part, of a tract of land which was conveyed on the twelfth day of November in the Year Seventeen hundred and eighty-nine for Gen. O. C. Williams, and called "Self Defence", the part hereby intended to be conveyed is embraced within the following lines viz: Beginning at the end of forty-two & two tenths perches on the sixth line of the whole tract and running thence with the outlines three lines viz: North Sixty-three degrees West forty-six & eight-tenths perches to a Stone, South thirty five degrees - West thirty-two perches to a stone thence North thirty one degrees East fifty eight perches to the beginning containing thirteen
