I, John Hobbs, of Frederick County, "Farmer", do make, and publish this my last Will, and Testament, as follows, - First I direct that, all I have and possess in Real Estate or personal property, shall go to my beloved Wife Eleanor, as long as she may live, and after her death to our children, as follows, - first to my daughter Elizabeth Catharine the sum of Two hundred dollars, and to my daughter Rebecca Agnes the sum of Three hundred dollars, all the furniture and household Effects to go to my Daughter Elizabeth C. and Rebecca A. the residue of my Estate to be equally divided amongst my several children, as follows, namely, Lewis A. Charles F. Joseph A. Joshua, Mary "Widow of John Walter Sr." Elizabeth C., Ella "wife of James Kelly" Rebecca A., Benjamin, and Lydia "Wife of Alfred Riddlemeyer. The College of St. Joseph" or its Officers "situated near Emmittsburg, Frederick County, Maryland, to have control, of my son Lewis A. portion, to apply it for his use and benefit as they may see fit according to their good Judgment. And for my daughters Elizabeth C. and Rebecca A. to have control, of my daughter Lydia's portion, and use it for her benefit, as they may think best. And it is my Will, and desire that Ella's portion be invested in a home, for her to have, and to hold, as long as she may live and after her death to be equally divided amongst her children, My Son Joseph to attend to it for her, that is, the buying of the home. And I do hereby make, and ordain my beloved wife Executor, of this my last Will, and Testament - In Testimony whereof I John Hobbs the Testator, have to this my Will set my hand, and, - this sixth day June in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred, and Seventy - Nine John Hobbs
