Cause in which it is pray that this petition be filed praying among
other things, for a Decree to be passed by Your Honorable Court for the
said Real Estate of Jane Kohlhaas, which decree was accordingly passed
in which John C. Mottet, and C. V. Levy were appointed Trustees to sell
said real estate, all of which appears by the proceedings in said
abovementioned Equity Cause.

3rd That the said Trustees have sold said real estate to Charles Kohlhaas
for the sum of \$810-, which sale has been reported to Your Honorable Court
and has been finally satisfied and confirmed by Your Honorable Court -

4th This Petitioner further represents that, the said Jane Kohlhaas, at
the time of her death was indebted unto Your Petitioner in the sum of One
Hundred and Forty three dollars and four cents, which is still due
and unpaid, the account for the same is herewith filed, as Exhibit No 1
to this petition and is pray to be taken as a part hereof.

5th That the said Jane Kohlhaas left a very small personal Estate, which
is totally and wholly insufficient to pay her debts, and that the proceeds
of sale of her real estate should be made liable for the same.

6th That the said Jane Kohlhaas left surviving her the following heirs
at law Your Petitioner Justus Martin, Charles Kohlhaas, Hannah Star-
field wife of Lycurgus Starfield, Rebecca Trail, Charles Trail, Margaret
Bayliss, Wife of Henry Bayliss, Teresa J. Smith, wife of Charles Smith
Margrett Trail, Mollie Trail, Notty Trail, Hanson Trail, and Ashwood
Trail, all of whom are defendants in the above cause and that said Justus
Martin is her Administrator.

Your Petition prays Your Honors to pass an order directing the Auditor
of Your Honorable Court to allow the abovementioned claim of Your
Petitioner in stating an account of the proceeds of sale of the real estate
sold by said Trustees, and such other relief as the nature of his case
may require
