Exhibit No 2. This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of December Eighty nine  
 hundred and forty-five between Henry Starbough of the one part and Anthony  
 Breighner of the other part, all of Frederick County, and State of Maryland,  
 Witnesseth, that they the said Henry Starbough and Martha his wife for and  
 in consideration of the sum of Seventy five dollars to them in hand paid  
 by the said Anthony Breighner before the sealing and delivery of these presents,  
 the receipt Whereof they do hereby acknowledge and to be, therewith fully  
 satisfied and paid, hath granted, bargained, sold, enfeoffed, and confirmed,  
 and by these presents, doth grant bargain, sell, enfeoff, and confirm unto  
 him the said Anthony Breighner his heirs, and assigns all that part of a  
 tract of land lying and being in the County aforesaid, being part of the  
 survey called "Margaret and James Partnership" Beginning for said part  
 at a Pile of stones at the end of the 8th line of the deed from John a  
 Valentine and Susan Valentine to Henry Starbough of John, then running with  
 the 9th. line of said deed North 49 degrees East twenty Perches to a stone  
 Pile, then North twenty three and a half degrees West thirty six Perches  
 to a stake, then South forty five degrees West thirty three and a half perches  
 to a public Road then with said road South forty two, and a half degrees  
 East thirty-one, and a quarter perches to the end of thirty eight perches  
 on the eighth line of the aforesaid deed then with said line North sixty  
 degrees East two perches to the place of beginning, containing five and five  
 eighths Acres of land more or less. Together with all the woods and appurtenances
