forever, but in the event of his leaving no children, then said portion of my estate, as devised in trust to him to be equally divided, and given to Sarah A. A Pampel and Mary C Simpson for their own use and behoof forever. I further insist and direct that if any of my children, are not satisfied with above disposition of my property and attempt to render its provisions null, and void, that in such case he she or they shall be debared forever from any benefit to be realized from any portion my estate, whatever, and lastly I do hereby constitute Capt. James M. Shury to be sole executor of this my last Will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former Wills by me hitherto made, ratifying and confirming this, and none other to be my last Will, and Testament.

In Testimony Whereof I hereunto set my hand, and seal this 20th day, of August in the year 1882.
