This Deed, made this 27th day of March in the year Eighteen Hundred and sixty five by Jacob Michael and his wife Catharine Michael, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth, that in consideration of Nine Hundred dollars, the said Jacob Michael and his wife Catharine Michael, do grant unto Edward Rantzahn and Daniel Den of the said County, all the following described part of a tract of land situated in Frederick County, aforesaid, and being part of a tract of land called "Heath's Abode" surveyed for John McNeel on the 15th day of January 1833, and corrected, and amended on the 15th day of January 1835, being also part of the deed from John and Hannah McNeel to the said Jacob Michael, dated on the 20th day of May 1806 and being Lot Nos 1, 2 & 3 as laid out for the said Jacob Michael on the 18th day of March 1865, Lot No. 1. Containing eight, acres, three rods, and twelve perches, Lot No. 2 Containing ten acres, one rood, and ten perches, and Lot No. 3 containing Fifteen, and a half, acres, be each more or less, in fee simple. The land hereby intended to be conveyed being all that part of the aforesaid Deed from John and Hannah McNeel dated on the 20th day of May Eighteen Hundred and thirty-six & recorded in Liber N. S. No. 3, folia 212 &c. One of the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid, which has not been sold, and conveyed heretofore by the said Jacob Michael and his wife. - - - - -
