Boyer I have taken the expenses of the second sale and the net loss between the first and second sale, and allowed to Aaron the residue of his share. Out of the residue of Latin H. Boyer's share I allowed to Ramsburg Hooge & Co, the amount of their judgment against Latin H Boyer and to Aaron Boyer the value of his share, and interest on the growing crops on the farm under his Petition, and the profits thereon and allowed to Latin H Boyer the balance of his share.
