 2- That as your Petitioner is now advised "Hattie Engel holds no note from said N. H. Naill payable to her, but that there are two notes which are filed in this case, One from said N. H. Naill to Mary Ann Engel for twenty-five dollars, and the other for two hundred dollars payable to Ephraim Storer, or order, and by him assigned to said Mary Ann Engel, and both of which said Notes have been protested by Ephraim St. Storer Executor of Mary Ann Engel dec'd, and your Petitioner has been informed that the Money on said Notes is due Hattie Engel, but there is nothing on the face of the Notes to show the fact.  
 3. That if the said Notes are paid to said Hattie Engel there will be no surplus for distribution among the General Creditors, but your Petitioner does not feel safe to decide that question for himself, wherefore he prays the protection of your Honorable Court, and that he may be authorized to give the usual Notice to said Creditors, and for such other relief to which he may be entitled.
