Snyder of Frederick County in the state of Maryland do make and publish this as my last will and testament in manner and form following - First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named and after my debts and funeral charges are paid I leave and bequeath as follows.

I give unto my beloved wife Annie Mary the income arising from my whole estate for the maintenance of herself and the maintenance of my daughter Almira and for the maintenance of any child or children to whom my wife may give birth during my life or be pregnant with at the time of my decease until the youngest child shall arrive at years of majority at which time I direct that my estate shall be divided equally between my wife and daughter Almira and any child or children to whom she may give birth during my life or be pregnant with at the time of my decease In case my daughter or child or children mentioned in the foregoing clause shall die before they attain their majority and my wife should survive them I then give my whole estate to my wife in fee simple. I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Annie Mary to be the Executor of this my last will and testament.
