3^d Int. Did the said Charlotte C. Long leave any children or other heirs at law?

If yes state their names ages and residences and of any one married the name of their husbands or wives?

Ans She died leaving a husband and seven children her husband has died since her death and also a son Charles M. who died without having heirs or children or any will
