To the Hon. the Judges of said Court.

1st The above Complainants say that on the 24th day of January 1889 a certain Beall H. Whalen died intestate seized and possessed of the following real estate, situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, to wit, a certain house and lot of ground situate on the north east corner of Patrick and East Streets in the City of Frederick, a house and lot of ground on the East side of Market Street in said City, and designated on the Plat thereof as Lots No 61 & 62 and two (2) lots of ground, situate in New Market District in said County, containing in the aggregate twenty five acres & thirty three perches, more or less - all of which pieces and parcels of ground have particularly described in a certain deed from J. Nelson Trustee to the said Beall H. Whalen dated September 5th 1887 and recorded in Liber N. S. C. No. 4 folio 499. And of the Land Records of said County also another piece or parcel of land being & being situate in said County known as The Reamery on Hawkins Neck Prop. O'Day together with another piece or parcel of land adjoining the same, the whole containing two hundred & seventy three acres more or less, and particularly described in a certain deed dated February 7th 1887 from Lewis Marshall President of the Frederick Town Savings Institution Trustee to the said Beall H. Whalen and recorded in Liber N. S. C. No. 4 folio 18 and of the Land Records of Frederick County. Copies of which said deeds are herewith filed marked respectively "Exhibit A" and "Exhibit B." and which are prayed to be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint.

2^d That defendant Margaret Remsburg, Tho. N. Harwood Trustee and John B. Thomas each has a mortgage on certain parts of said real estate from the said Beall H. Whalen, copies whereof are herewith filed & marked respectively "Exhibit C" "Exhibit D" & "Exhibit E" & which are prayed to be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint - and that defendant Susan Whalen administratrix of John W. Whalen has a judgment which is a lien on said Real Estate a copy of which said judgment is herewith filed and marked "Exhibit F." & prayed to be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint.

3^d That the said Beall H. Whalen left the following representatives, his heirs at law and next of kin to whom said real estate descended as tenants in common
