Frederick White, a witness of lawful age and sound mind on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined *in vivo*, deposes and says as follows - Frederick White is my name, my age is 66 years and I reside in Frederick County. I knew George H. Eyles in his lifetime and he is dead. He was a resident of Frederick County Md. but died that Virginia about the month of October 1888. He left no widow surviving him, but did leave two minor children as his heirs at law, whose names are Frederick H. Eyles and Emma H. Eyles, they are unmarried and reside in Frederick County. Mr. Eyles was at the time of his death seized and possessed of the real estate described in Exhibit No. 4. now shown me. He purchased of Henry Ronger since deceased one hundred acres of Mountain land adjoining the lands of John Ronger and John H. Ronger and others situated in Frederick County for which he never received a deed. at the time of his death he owed \$80.00 on the purchase money which is now due to John H. Ronger Executor of Henry Ronger. There is a Mortgage on the land described in Exhibit No. 4. which said Mortgage is herein filed as Exhibit No. 1. There was due at the time of the death of George H. Eyles on said Mortgage the sum of \$300. with interest from the 26th day of March 1884, less \$120⁰⁰ paid by him which includes all interest allowed as his payments up to May 1889. I am the administrator in Md. of George H. Eyles. His personal Estate is not sufficient to pay all his just debts due and owing at the time of his death. and in fact his real and personal estate both will not be sufficient to pay them. None of the judgment filed as Exhibit No. 2. has been paid.
