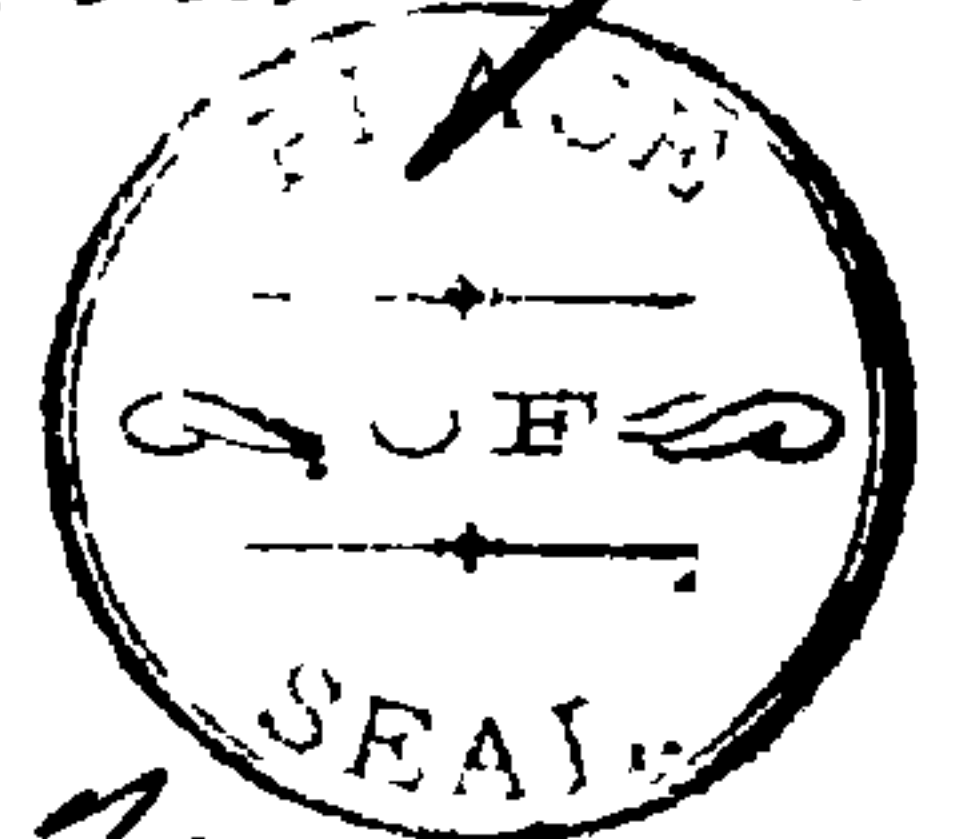

At the request of David Ramberg the following deed is received for record and recorded June 3, 1889 at 10 o'clock 25 minutes A.M. Test W. Irving Parsons, Clerk

This Deed made this Eighth day of June A.D. Eighteen hundred and sixty one, by Dennis Ramberg and Lydia Ramberg his wife. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars having been paid, the said Dennis Ramberg and Lydia Ramberg his wife doth grant unto David Ramberg, a certain piece of parcel of land known as Lot No. 6, the said Lot being part of a tract of land called 'The case of Necessity' situate in Frederick County State of Maryland and which was conveyed to the said Dennis Ramberg by Thomas Pickett by deed dated July 28<sup>th</sup> in the year 1858 and commencing for the outlines thereof at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> line of the deed from Samuel Devilbiss to George Gills for 5 acres and running thence with said deed correcting the same S 76 1/4° W 40 ps. thence N 5° W 46 ps. to the end of 76 1/4 ps. on the second line of Lot No. 5 then by and with said line, S 83° E 48 3/4 ps to the end thereof being on the outline of the parcel of land sold by Dennis Devilbiss to Daniel Honck and with said outlines, S 9 3/8° W 31 1/2 ps. to the place of beginning. Containing 10 acres 1 rood and 20 perches of land

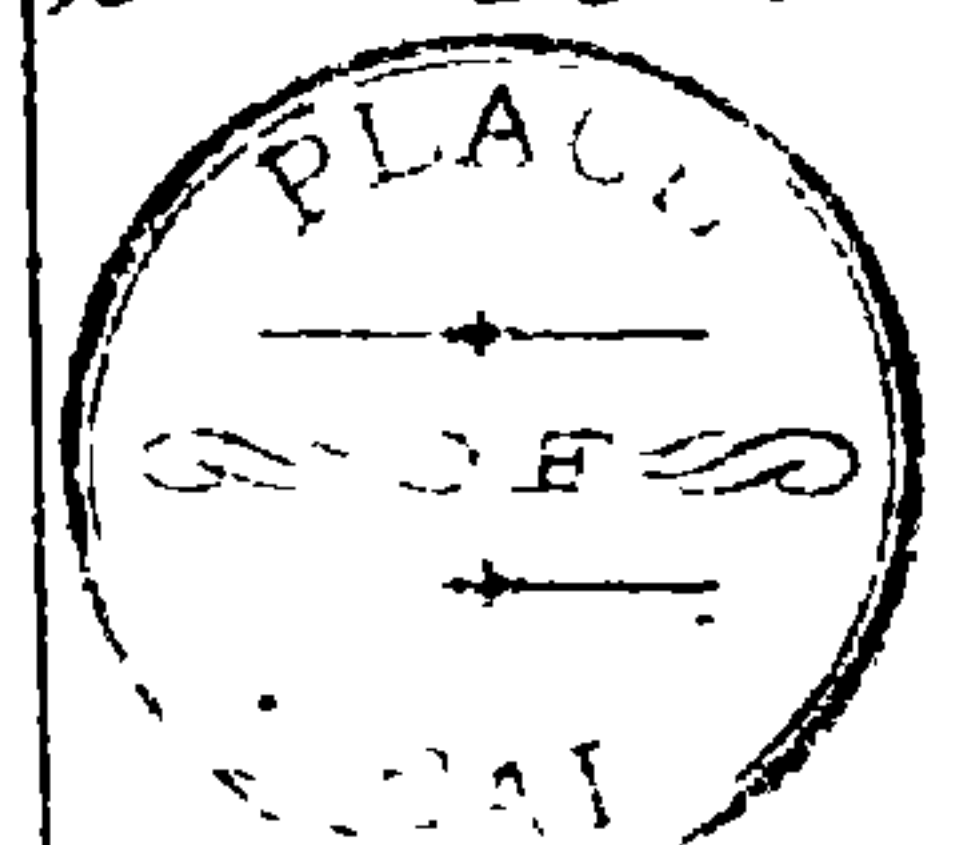
